
VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY DESCRIPTIONS

MEAL DELIVERY Our delivery volunteers bring meals to our homebound clients and usually volunteer once a week on the same day every week. Volunteer route drivers are our biggest need! We will work with you to find an available route on a day that fits your schedule. Most routes take approximately 60-75 minutes and are driven between 11:00 am and 12:30 pm. Delivery volunteers use their personal vehicles and need a dependable means of transportation, a current, valid driver's license and proof of auto insurance.

ON CALL/SUBSTITUTE MEAL DELIVERY Volunteers with a flexible schedule would be called as a substitute to deliver a route in the event a scheduled volunteer driver has to cancel. Substitute drivers are an important part of our team.

SITE DROP DRIVER Volunteers would pick up packed coolers at the main site and "drop" them to the delivery volunteers at designated sites.

KITCHEN/FOOD PREP ASSISTANCE Volunteers work as a team and follow an organized process to package the freshly cooked food for the day's meals. Volunteers work in the kitchen of Good Samaritan Medical Center. Special dress requirements include long pants & closed toed shoes. Hairnet & gloves are provided. Hours for this position are from 9:15 to 11:00 am.

KITCHEN PACKER/ROUTE ORGANIZER Volunteer would assist with food preparation if needed, and then would pack the food into hot and cold bags by route.

ON CALL/SUBSTITUTE KITCHEN/FOOD PREP ASSISTANCE Volunteers with a flexible schedule would be called for food prep assistance in the event a scheduled volunteer has to cancel. Substitute kitchen volunteers are an important part of our team.

OFFICE ADMINISTRATION Volunteers assist in the office on an as-needed basis with data entry, customer support, special projects, mailings & other tasks that may be available. Volunteers may also be fully trained to meet with new clients (at the clients home) to sign them up for the program. (Clients are qualified over the phone first by the staff). Intake volunteers would work in teams of two.

OUTREACH/SPECIAL EVENTS Volunteers would assist with events that may occur during the year such as the annual Fundraising Event, and other outreach-recruitment and special events that are scheduled. Assistance with preparing invitations, event set-up, break-down, registration, publicity, and other miscellaneous tasks are options to consider.

You must be 18 years of age or older to volunteer for these positions. All applicants must pass a background check.
